Fasting and medication instructions

Admissions up to and including 12 midday, you:

- SHOULD have supper as late as you wish, but before midnight on day before your procedure
- MUST NOT eat anything (this includes chewing gum and sweets) after midnight
- MAY drink WATER ONLY freely until 2 hours before your admission time. No milk.
- MUST take all routine medications (unless told otherwise by your surgeon or anaesthetist)

Admission after 12 midday, you:

- SHOULD have a LIGHT breakfast before 7:00 am e.g. Tea and up to 2 slices of toast or a light cereal. (No porridge or cooked breakfast)
- MUST NOT eat anything (this includes chewing gum and sweets) after 7:00am
- MAY, after 7am, drink WATER ONLY freely until 2 hours before your admission time. No milk.
- MUST take all routine medications (unless told otherwise by your surgeon or anaesthetist)

If your Surgeon or Anaesthetist gives you other fasting instructions, you MUST COMPLY WITH THEM

Colonoscopy Patients

You must follow the bowel prep and diet instruction provided by your specialist. If you have concerns please contact your specialist.

Other medication instructions

Please read admission information on website regarding 'Your current medications'

Please bring all your usual medications in their original containers to hospital with you, including herbal and dietary supplements.

Checklist / reminder

- Obtain **prior approval** from your insurance company
- Complete and return the E-admission forms
- Phone the hospital if you have any further questions regarding estimates during 9am to 4 pm Monday to Friday
- Ensure any laboratory tests requested by your specialist have been completed before your admission
- □ If you are paying your account privately you will need to arrange prepayment of your estimated account
- □ If you are to be admitted overnight and have been clinically employed at a hospital or rest home or admitted to a hospital in NZ or overseas in the last 6 months please contact your specialists' rooms
- Have copies of any enacted Advance Directive
- Arrange transport to and from the hospital
- Arrange for a responsible adult to stay with you at home for the first 24 hours after discharge

Bring to Wakefield on admission:

□ Consent form for your procedure

- Admission form and Health Questionnaire if not completed on-line or sent in prior to admission
- □ Prior approval letter from insurance company
- ACC letter authorising your treatment in a private hospital
- □ Print out of medications list from your GP
- \Box Glasses and any other physical aids
- Arrange transport to and from the hospital.

Inpatients only:

- □ Suitable night wear and dressing gown
- □ Comfortable footwear
- □ Personal toiletries
- \Box Reading and writing material
